This has a very ripe, almost muscular core of creamed melon, meringue and lemon gelée, with the frame of chartreuse, quinine and chamomile providing contrast and balance. The long, lingering finish has nice cut. Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon. Drink now through 2018.

2009 Chateau Haut Bergey Pessac Leognan Blanc 87-90 points

(80% sauvignon blanc and 20% semillon; 14% alcohol) Straw-yellow with gold highlights. The initially intensely oaky nose slowly reveals mineral and citrus fruit aromas along with rather obvious burnt almond and caramel notes. Then surprisingly fresh and clean in the mouth, with pretty gooseberry and tangerine flavors complicated by vanilla and green fig. The moderately long finish displays a saline edge. This vintage of Haut-Bergey was aged in more new oak than usual (up to 50%, vs. a more usual 30%), and though the wine shows considerable potential, it will need time to bring that oaky veneer into balance.
