A blend of 80% Sauvignon Blanc and 20% Semillon raised in 50% new oak and the rest one-year old, the Haut-Bergey Blanc has a refined bouquet of lemon thyme and dried apricot that is well defined – the oak nicely integrated. The palate is medium-bodied with crisp acidity, hints of praline and passion fruit with a crisp, focused finish.
